The Vermont Art Teachers Association is offering two Rejuvenation Grants of up to \$150 for supplies to use for a special project in your art room. Members often mention inadequate supply budgets as a significant obstacle to providing quality and innovative art education to their students.

ALL VATA and NAEA members can fill out a short application to apply for the grant and purchase supplies (art materials and art history prints or books) to do a project that will enhance art education in your school or community center

Applications are due on February 12 and will be reviewed by an independent source. We will award the grant on March 11th to kick off our Youth Art Month observance at the Vermont Alliance For The Arts Conference. Grant recipients will be asked to provide visual documentation of their project to be displayed on the VATA website to inspire other art educators.
